Technology Resource File

For this task, you will develop an electronic file on an early childhood topic that includes information relating to advocacy. The goal of the electronic file is to provide professional development to others. File requirements include the following:

- 10-12 evidence-based resources related to advocacy on the topic of your choices that are supportive of professional development
- Coherent organization and access
